St Peter's is a Church of England church that has been at the heart of Rock Ferry since 1844. Today, our aim is that St Peter's feels like a home from home, a church family where everyone is welcome. Our main meeting is at 10.30am (tea and toast from 10:00am), a gathering of all ages with something for everyone. We spend time all together before the children and young people go to their groups, enabling all ages to explore the bible in a fun, creative and safe environment. We have a Sunday dub for children aged 4-11 and Pathies for young people of 11-14. There is also a crèche for children aged 0-4 years.

At 4:30pm we have a weekly 'all age' service, designed to be child friendly with craft, activities and refreshments. Its very informal and lasts approximately one hour.
